
Pros: It offers a host of features and tools to monitor, filter, block and report computer and internet use.

Cons: No real time monitoring available

Cost: \$97

Platform: Mac, PC, Android, iOS


Pros: It offers the most monitoring, blocking and reporting features compared to other software.

Cons: Not available for Mac and doesn't allow blocking by category

Cost: \$69.95 (Stealth Version available at \$79.95)

Internet Filter

	Internet Filter Be in control of your internet. Set filtering for 18 categories of online content to either block, warn, or allow for view. [learn more]
	Block Pornography Warn or block access to pornography and other adult content. [learn more]
	Time Management Set the total number of Internet hours in a day or set specific times of the day when your child can be online. [learn more]
	Mask Profanity View a web page without being bombarded by vulgar language. [learn more]
	Social Media Monitoring Net Nanny Social helps protect kids from online threats and monitors activities related to your child's "friends," cyberbullying, sexual predators, privacy concerns, and reputation-damaging pictures or videos. [learn more]
	Alerts and Reporting Receive reports and mail alerts about your child's online activity. [learn more]
	Remote Admin Check usage reports, change your child's profile settings, and much more, from any computer with an Internet connection. [learn more]
	User Profiles Use preset user profiles or customize settings for each family member; unlimited user profiles for each computer.



Cell Phones Designed for Kids



Technology: Managing & Monitoring with Confidence

- Pay-to-go service designed for kids
- Set time limits of when the device can and can't be used
- Built in GPS (only at smart phones)
- Block unwanted calls
- Web filtering (only on data, and limited on non-android devices)
- Carries over Sprint devices
